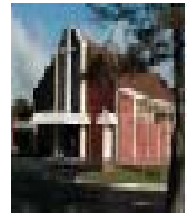

Readings: Is 50:4-7; Phil 2:6-11; Lk 22:14 – 23:56

Passion According to St Luke: (Passion Reading Booklet page 30)

During the reading of the Passion the Congregation sits. In your booklets the sections are marked by: N read by the Narrator; ☩ read by the Celebrant; C read by the Third Reader; All read by the Congregation.

Blessing of the Palms: Simple blessing before each Mass.

Before 9am Mass, the Blessing takes place outside the School Library at 8.45am followed by Procession to the Church (weather permitting).

Responsorial Psalm: 21 (Psalm to be said by congregation alternately – reader's side first followed by the Priest's side)

Readers Side:

All who see me deride me.
They curl their lips, they toss their heads.
'He trusted in the Lord, let him save him;
let him release him if this is his friend.'

Priests Side:

Many dogs have surrounded me,
a band of the wicked beset me.
They tear holes in my hands and my feet.
I can count every one of my bones.

Readers Side:

They divide my clothing among them.
They cast lots for my robe.
O Lord, do not leave me alone,
my strength, make haste to help me!

Priests Side:

I will tell of your name to my brethren
and praise you where they are assembled.
'You who fear the Lord give him praise;
all sons of Jacob, give him glory.
Revere him, Israel's sons.'
