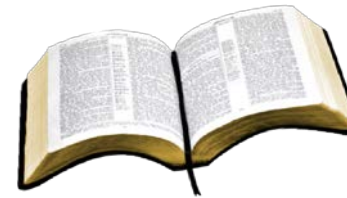

Pro-Life Facts: According to Dr Joel Brind PhD, an epidemiologist from New York, 57 studies since 1957 show a link between abortion and breast cancer as opposed to 15 that don't.
