Slow down!** The front of church can be used to “drop off” elderly and physical disabled passengers. but must be left clear to allow for emergency vehicles when needed. Be aware that any illegal parking could result in your car being towed away at the owners' expense by Auckland Transport.

**Student Safety:** Please note that the tennis court gates will be locked **on school days** from **10 am to 2.30pm** (to 2.40pm on Mondays) to ensure the school children's safety during the morning break, lunch time and during sports / physical education. Owners of vehicles that remain on the courts during this period, do so **at their own risk**. Both the parish and school will NOT be liable for any damage to cars, should you NOT wish to find alternative parking during this period.
