

**ProLife Facts**: Voice for Life is currently hosting an online campaign "We Deserve Better" to raise awareness about the impact of abortion on women in New Zealand. Many New Zealanders are probably unaware that Māori women are over-represented in abortion statistics. That is, although Māori make up only 15% of the population, 23% of all abortions in 2017 were performed on Māori women. Māori women had 3,111 abortions in 2017. Nevertheless, the Law Commission proposes that we need more abortion clinics in areas with large Māori populations. But Voice for Life believes that we should be first looking into this issue in more depth - to see why so many Māori wahine are having abortions, and what abortion is doing to Māori whanau and communities.
