ProLife Facts: The Cabinet of the Coalition Government is considering abortion law reform. Speculation is that abortion will be allowed for any reason up to 20 weeks. A decision could be weeks or months away. In the meantime, a deluge of pro-abortion stories is pouring out from online news outlets such as Stuff, Newsroom and The Spinoff. The media in general support abortion without limits. and the anti-abortion movement is struggling to make their voices heard. The latest development are surveys purporting to convince the general public and especially MPs, that the majority of Kiwis support abortion on demand. In contrast, a 2016 survey commissioned by Family First and conducted by independent polling company Curia Market Research found that 56% of women surveyed, wanted shorter, not longer time limits for abortion - and only 9% believed that abortions should be allowed at 20 weeks.
