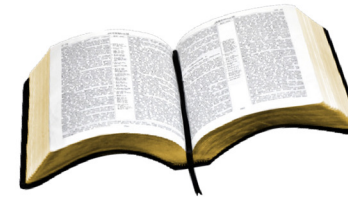

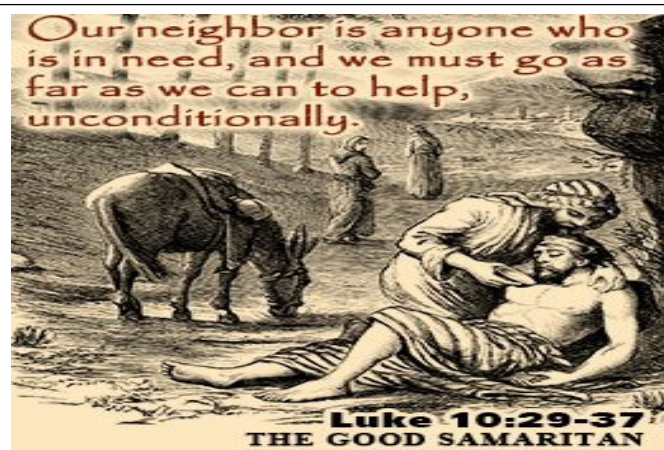
## HOLY CROSS PARISH NOTICES
