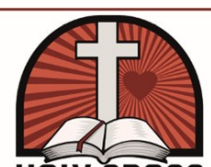

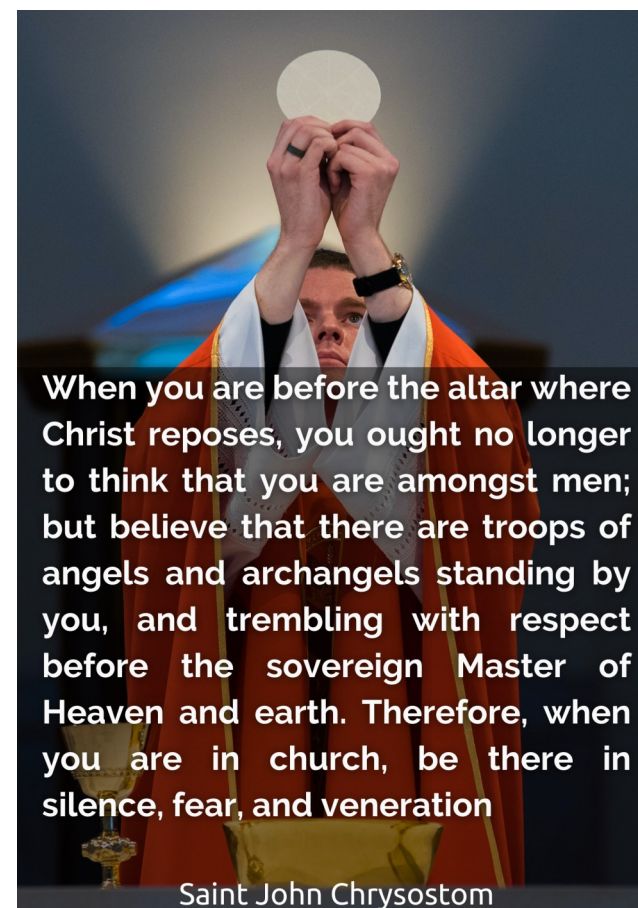
Communion Reflection

First Holy Communion and Confirmation—Bishop has informed he will officiate only to dispense the Sacrament of Confirmation to candidates at the Parish. First Holy Communion will be celebrated on 6th November 2022. Confirmation Service will be held on 20th November 2022. Forms are available in the church foyer & parish office.
