


Foyer– We kindly invite everyone to join us inside the church and take a seat—there's no need to stand in the foyer. For Health and Safety reasons, please keep the doorway clear, as it serves as an emergency exit.

Preference Card—will be signed by appointment only, every Tuesday from 11am until 12:00pm. To complete a Preference Enrolment Certificate you must be a registered parishioner of Holy Cross Parish Henderson. Additionally, you also must provide a copy of your child's baptism certificate. There is a new requirement for Option 5.4, if the child is not yet baptized in the Catholic Faith, a baptism certificate of the guardian, aunt, uncle or grandparent requesting the child's enrolment in a Catholic School, along with supporting form. Once completed and signed by our priest's the form will be emailed to the diocese for approval. Parents must wait for the Diocesan approval before enrolling their child.

Safeguarding– Parental Supervision: For the safety of all, please accompany your children in the church at all times. We prioritize everyone's well-being, especially the vulnerable.

Code of Conduct Poster by the Diocese. Please take your time to read it as the Code of Conduct is not only for volunteers but for everyone who comes in our church whether they are volunteers, parishioners, contractor or a visitor, we expect everyone to act respectfully to one another. *SAFE CHURCH FOR EVERY DAY!
