



This feast originated in France in the mid thirteenth century and was extended to the whole Church by Pope Urban IV in 1264.

This feast calls us to focus on two manifestations of the Body of Christ, the Holy Eucharist and the Church. The primary purpose of this feast is to focus our attention on the Eucharist. The opening prayer at Mass calls our attention to Jesus' suffering and death and our worship of Him, especially in the Eucharist. The secondary focus of this feast is upon the Body of Christ as it is present in the Church. The Church is called the Body of Christ because of the intimate communion which Jesus shares with his disciples. He expresses this in the gospels by using the



metaphor of a body in which He is the head. This image helps keep in focus both the unity and the diversity of the Church.

Corpus Cristi—Sunday 22nd of June is the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ. We will be processing the Blessed Sacrament before the 10:30am Mass.
