


Rejoicing in the Cross!

"Go and tell John what you hear and see: the blind regain their sight, the lame walk, lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the poor have the good news proclaimed to them. And blessed is the one who takes no offense at me." Matthew 11: 4-6

Imagine being our Blessed Mother who witnessed it all, stood by her Son as He endured His Cross, and rejoiced with Him when He rose. Unquestionably, if we asked our Blessed Mother whether she preferred to see a few miracles from her Son or to witness His perfect sacrifice that brought salvation to the world, her holy and sorrowful heart would choose the latter.





Advent Wreath & Meaning of Each Candle

We wait with hope for Christ, the Light of the world.

The Advent wreath is a beautiful symbol the Church uses to help us prepare our hearts for the coming of Christ at Christmas. Its circular shape represents God's eternal love—without beginning or end. The evergreen branches remind us of the hope of eternal life.

The wreath holds four candles, each representing a key theme of Advent. Traditionally, three candles are purple (symbolizing penance and preparation) and one is rose (symbolizing joy).

First Candle - The Prophecy Candle (Hope) Colour: Purple. Meaning: Hope and expectation. Symbolism: Reminds us of the prophets—especially Isaiah—who foretold the coming of the Messiah. Message:

Second Candle - The Angel's Candle (Peace) Colour: Purple. Meaning: Peace. Symbolism: Reminds us of the angels' message: "Peace on earth and good will

to all.". Message: Christ comes to bring peace to our hearts and to the world.

Third Candle - The Shepherd's Candle (Joy) Colour: Rose. Meaning: Joy - Gaudete Sunday. Symbolism: Reflects the joy the shepherds felt when they heard the good news of Jesus' birth. Message: In the midst of Advent's penitential spirit, we rejoice that the Lord is near.
