

	Responsorial Psalm Ps 119 Response: Blessed are they who follow the law of the Lord !
	Mission Statement of Our Parish "We the Catholic Community of the Holy Cross Parish Henderson, empowered by the Holy Spirit, accept and proclaim the Good News and strive to be one in God's love and to be of service to others".
The Law and the Prophets! Jesus said to his disciples: "Do not think that I have come to abolish the law or the prophets. I have come not to abolish but to fulfill. Amen, I say to you, until heaven and earth pass away, not the smallest letter or the smallest part of a letter will pass from the law, until all things have taken place." <i>Matthew 5: 17-18</i>	
In today's Gospel, after declaring that He came to fulfil the Law and the Prophets, Jesus provided three examples of how He brings the Old Testament moral law to its fulfilment. Though not included in today's Gospel, Jesus also brings the ceremonial laws to fulfilment by becoming the Lamb of God, offering Himself as the definitive High Priest on the new altar of the Cross. Furthermore, our Lord fulfils the prophets by establishing the New Covenant in His blood, as seen in Isaiah's vision of the Suffering Servant Who bears the sins of many (Isaiah 53), Jeremiah's promise of the new covenant written on hearts (Jeremiah 31:31-34), and Micah's prophecy of a ruler born in Bethlehem (Micah 5:2). Reflect today on God's Eternal Law, established before the foundation of the world and brought to fulfilment in Christ. The human life of the Son of God is the centre of time and eternity. Everything converges on Him, and new life flows from Him. Just as our Lord fulfils the Old Testament, He also is the only source of true fulfilment in our lives. Ponder His mission and renew your choice to accept His New Covenant, written on your heart by grace. Doing so is an exercise in Divine Wisdom, giving you a share in the new life of grace, made possible by His blood. Glorious Lawgiver and Messiah, Your Wisdom is perfect, eternal, and transforming. All things came to be through You and find their fulfilment in You. I thank You for the gift of Your Eternal Law and pray for the grace to live it to perfection, with the aid of Your saving grace.

Chewing gum in church is generally considered *disrespectful, distracting, and inappropriate*, as it violates the solemnity and decorum of a sacred space. It is considered poor etiquette and is advised against in most religious traditions, including Catholic services, where it can interfere with fasting requirements for communion.

Key Reasons to Avoid Gum in Church:

- **Disrespect and Disruption:** It is seen as rude and distracting to others, signalling a lack of reverence for the service.
- **Fasting Rules (Catholicism):** Before receiving Holy Communion, Catholics are required to fast for one hour. Chewing gum and swallowing its flavours can be considered breaking this fast.
- **Focus:** It detracts from the focus on prayer, worship, and the liturgy.
- **Etiquette:** Similar to not wearing hats or using cell phones, removing gum is part of proper church behaviour.

IT IS BEST TO DISPOSE OF GUM BEFORE ENTERING THE CHURCH BUILDING.
